

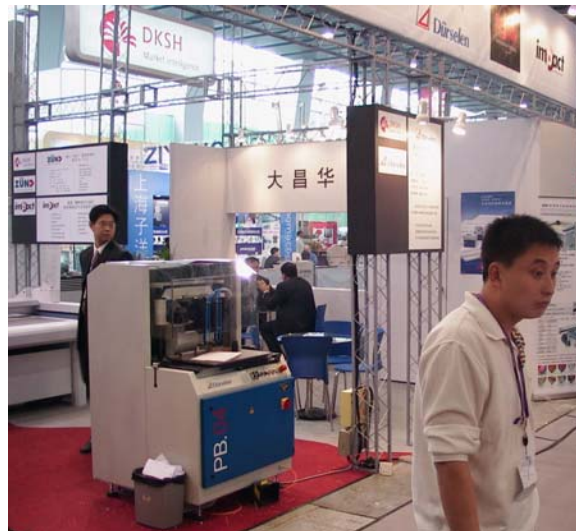


Dürselen paper drilling machines on display at international shows

2006 the show calendar for the graphic arts industry is again packed – regional, national and with IPEX also an international exhibition present up to date solutions to the visitors. Together with qualified sales partners Dürselen present their range of paper drilling machines in many countries.

● Asia

At **Printing South China** in *Guangzhou* Dürselen exhibited for the first time together with their Chinese dealer **DKSH**. To show the broad range of possible applications model PB.04N was equipped with two triple-spindle drill heads. This equipment is used for drilling narrow spacing for organiser hole patterns like e.g. Filofax © - an application that produced the visitors' interest. In June of this year **All in Print 2006** in *Shanghai, China*, is an additional opportunity DKSH uses for the market introduction of Dürselen paper drills.



● Europe



IPEX 2006 in *Birmingham* was a successful show for Dürselen with many promising contacts to British customers as well as foreign dealers and users. The British dealer for Dürselen paper drills, **G.A.E.** created with the "netWORKflow zone" a highly integrated production system including also the Dürselen range of paper drills and finishing systems. The automated paper drilling system PB.15 stands out by its output up to 1,500 piles per hour, processing piles of loose leaves as well as piles of perfect bound and stitched products.

Another interesting application was shown on the modular paper drill PB.16: drilling multiple holes for mechanical binding instead of punching.

At **Grafitalia** in *Milan, Italy*, Dürselen will have machines on two stands. **D.G. Vianini** shows a paper drilling system PB.12 Gantry in line with a Kolbus perfect binder. This machine runs an output of 1,200 piles per hour and unit.



For the smaller and medium sized paper drills Dürselen found a new sales partner **Multi-Import**. At their stand models UD-04 and PB.04 N will be on display. Both are four-spindle drilling machines, the first an entry level model, the second one fully equipped for professional and flexible work.

● USA



The US-American dealer for Dürselen paper drills, Rollem Corporation of America, attends – as every year – many regional and national shows for the Graphic Arts industry.

After a very successful open house in March follows **Print Fest** in *Long Beach, CA*, in May, another regional exhibition. In October **Graph Expo** in *Chicago* rounds off the international trade show calendar for Dürselen paper drills. At Graph Expo Rollem will demonstrate paper drilling machines for file holes, multi-holes for mechanical binding and for automated paper drilling.
